

# Race Day Information for Duathlon Participants

Greetings racers! Sprint and Splash is only a few days away. Here is all the information you need for a fun and successful race day!

# Location

The event will be held at Lake St. Clair Metropark: 31300 Metropolitan Parkway, Harrison Township, MI.

The entire event (start and finish) will be staged at the main beach area, south of the park office building.

# **Packet Pick-up**

Participants may pick up your packet on Friday, July 12 between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. and also on Saturday, July 13 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Packet pick-up will be located in a large, white tent near the main beach. **As a reminder, the park charges a \$10 entry fee per car.** 

# Kayak & SUP Board Drop-off

On Saturday during packet pick-up, there will be a kayak and SUP board drop-off zone near the park office. If you need assistance, park personnel will pick up your vessel and transport it to the transition zone. **Unfortunately this year we are not able to offer drop-off on Friday evening.** 

As a reminder, you are responsible for providing your own kayak or SUP board. If you have rented from Simple Adventures they will be on site on Saturday to answer any questions.

# Schedule of Events

The duathlon begins with the 5k run portion, which starts at 8:30 a.m. Immediately following the completion of the 5k run, you will enter the transition zone, where your kayak or SUP board will be stored. You DO NOT cross the finish line until you have completed the 2-mile paddle. You will receive three times: 5k run, 2 mile paddle and total.

Participants are required to complete the Duathlon in two hours or less. All runners must be in the transition zone within 45 minutes of the 5K start and on the water within an hour. After the two hour mark, the Sheriff's will tow you to shore.
