

Race Day Information for 2-Mile Paddle Participants

Greetings racers! Sprint and Splash is only a few days away. Here is all the information you need for a fun and successful race day!

Location

The event will be held at Lake St. Clair Metropark: 31300 Metropolitan Parkway, Harrison Township, MI.

The entire event (start and finish) will be staged at the main beach area, south of the park office building

Packet Pick-up

Participants may pick up your packet on Friday, July 12 between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. and also on Saturday, July 13 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Packet pick-up will be located in a large, white tent near the main beach. **As a reminder, the park charges a \$10 entry fee per car.**

Kayak & SUP Board Drop-off

On Saturday during packet pick-up, there will be a kayak and SUP board drop-off zone near the park office. If you need assistance, park personnel will pick up your vessel and transport it to the transition zone. **Unfortunately this year we are not able to offer drop-off on Friday evening.**

As a reminder, you are responsible for providing your own kayak or SUP board. If you have rented from <u>Simple Adventures</u> they will be on site on Saturday to answer any questions.

Schedule of Events

The 2-mile paddle will begin at approximately 8:45 a.m. The race will be a shotgun start and will launch from the waterfront area.

Awards

The award ceremony will be held at approximately 10:30 a.m. Medals will be awarded to:

1st, 2nd and 3rd overall (male and female).

This is a combined race, there will not be separate awards for kayaking and stand-up paddle boarding.

All participants will receive a finisher's medal.
